Structure and argument required when writing contact reports





Knowledge and understanding around 1 contact services

- Low impulsivity levels and a great capacity for patience and subject to commitment to child protection and to children as the paramount concern in all family matters.
- Quiet confidence sufficient for person centred empathy and authoritative intervention.
- Full awareness of the risk assessment and what to observe during contact.
- All sensitive information is kept confidential.
- Staggered arrangements are adhered to in the interest of all involved.



Structure and argument required when 2 writing contact reports

- Your report has excellent narrative structure throughout and the writing is professionally perceptive and persuasive.
- Explicit acknowledgment of other pertinent areas of the contact session otherwise not covered in other sections of the report.
- The report addresses any concerns if any, raised on referral form and the contact worker observations.
- Logical and articulate analysis is a consistent feature.



Clear expression and written 3 communication

- Capacity for painstaking attention to detail in assessing, observing and recording children's attachments and interactions.
- The report is fit for purpose and detailed enough to be useful.
- Well written report with excellent punctuation, grammar and spelling.

Individuals who consistently produce excellent reports will be remunerated.
